The Foundation is working with the Park Board of Commissioners on the donor recognition plaque, which will be placed in the new picnic shelter at the park. The target date to have the plaque installed is June 1, 2009. Cumulative donations of \$1,000 or more from 2007-2009 will be recorded on the plaque recognizing the following donor levels:

- Special Benefactors \$20,000 and over
- Patron \$5,000-\$9,999
- Family \$1,000-2,499
- Benefactor \$10,000-\$19,999
- Contributor \$2,500-\$4,999
- Tree Sponsor \$1,000

In early March, all donors will receive a letter from the Foundation notifying you of the amount you have contributed to the project. At that time, additional donations and/or pledges, payable by December 31, 2009, may be made. That amount will then be added to your current donation total to determine your final donor level and plaques will be ordered.

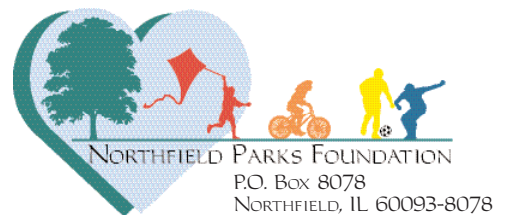
