General Information

Parent Manuals

Camp Staff & Communication

Each camp is supervised daily by a qualified adult director. Counselors at each camp are a mixture of mature and enthusiastic college and high school students. All camp staff members attend a training program, which includes supervision and safety techniques, activity development and first aid/CPR.

Residency Policy

Recreation program residency rates apply to everyone who lives within Park District boundaries. In general they are: West of railroad tracks, North of Winnetka Ave., East of Waukegan Rd, and South of Voltz Rd. Children who attend a school within the boundaries are also eligible for resident rates.

Our Online

Registration System

To use our online registration system go to our website at www.northfieldparkdistrict.org and click on the online icon. You will be asked for a User Name & Password. You should have been e-mailed these if you have registered for a park district program previously and provided us with an email address. If you are a new patron you will be instructed what to do on the site.

How to Register:

- Click on “shop” and select the “Activity Enrollment” link.
- Find the activity by either entering the activity number or using the search features.
- Click on the shopping cart to the left of desired activity or camp.
- Once the activity is selected, select the person to register from the drop down list. This will automatically default to the first person listed in the household, usually mom or dad.
- Click on the shopping cart at the bottom.
- Agree to the waiver.
- For all the day camps, you will need to select the weeks and days, if your child is attending three days/week.
- Click on the corresponding weeks that you choose above. Please make sure the number of weeks is correct.

- Proceed to checkout.
- Confirm person, weeks, days (if 3 days) and price.
- Enter credit card information.
- Proceed to authorize credit card and view receipt. A receipt will also be emailed to the email address on file in a PDF format.
- The last day to register on-line will be May 29th.

Once you have submitted your registration you will not be able to make any changes to that registration online. If you wish to make any changes you will need to contact the office at 847-446-4428 Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. It is always a good idea to print a receipt so you have proof of your registration.

Registration

Deadlines

Deadline to register for day camp (Giggle Gang, Trailblazers, Explorers and Sports Camp) is June 7th. Anyone registering after this date will be put on a waiting list and will be placed in the camp if there is room. There will be a \$40 penalty for all late registrations. Registration for specialty sport camps is due one week before the start of camp.

Transfers

Transfers from one camp to another are permitted until June 7th. No transfers are allowed after this date. This policy is strictly enforced to allow completion of staff hiring, camper groupings, supply ordering, activity scheduling, and informational mailings. Transfers cannot be done on-line.

Payment

Payment for camps is accepted by cash, check or credit card (Visa, Mastercard and Discover). Payment may be made in person at the Community Center located at 401 Wagner Rd, by mail or via fax at 847.446.4431. If you would like to pay via a payment plan please print form from website or pick one up at the Community Center.

Refund Policy

- If a refund request is made prior to May 24th a full refund, less a \$20 service charge per camp is granted.
- After May 24th a full refund, less a \$50 service charge per camp session is granted only through June 14.
- June 14 is the last day to request refunds. No refunds are granted once camp begins. No exceptions.
- We do not prorate additional weeks once camp has begun. You will need to pay the full amount for any added weeks after June 14th.

We do our best to issue refunds as quickly as possible, but delays are sometimes necessary to ensure accuracy. Check refunds take approximately two weeks. Credits to charge cards take six to eight weeks to appear on your statement. Refunds cannot be done on-line.

Registration Form

How to fill out the registration form on page 9:

1. Complete enclosed camper registration form. Be sure to fill in all information! Take extra care to fill in the correct program number and correct fee. Please make sure your registration is accurate.
2. Camps must be paid for in full at the time of registration unless using the payment plan.
3. Make checks payable to Northfield Park District. If you are paying by credit card, fill in credit card payment box as provided on the registration form.
4. Drop off your registration to Northfield Park District Community Center or mail to 401 Wagner Rd., Northfield, IL 60093 or fax to 847.446.4431.
